Office Order


Sub: Guidelines on the measurement to be taken by CCSNIAH for containment of COVID_19-reg

In continuation of office order of no. 1/4/2018-19/NIAH dated 20/03/2020 and order no. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 17/05/2020 issued by MHA on the above subject, I am directed to inform that keeping in view the essential services of the institute regarding QC testing of Veterinary vaccine in the country, it has been decided that CCSNIAH office will be opened regularly w.e.f. 18/05/2020. All the officers/staff is requested to attend the office regularly w.e.f 18/05/2020.

Apart from the existing sanitary and cleaning measures followed in the institute for the above cited purpose, the following additional measures of social distancing and reducing personnel movement and activity within the office and campus are to be followed from immediate effect:

1. The officers and staff of the institute are encouraged to wear mask and frequently clean their hands and use hand sanitizer.
2. Discourage, to the maximum extent, entry of visitors in the office complex and the entry to residence is to be regulated/restricted/guided as per the discretion of the staff/officer concerned.
3. Additionally the officers and staff of the institute are requested to adhere to the preventive guidelines issued by Department of Health and Family Welfare and Ministry of Home Affairs for individual safety and protection.
4. All the officers and staff will not leave the station without prior permission of the competent authority.
5. It is mandatory to download 'Aarogyasetu' App on their mobile phones immediately and follow the direction/instruction contained therein strictly to improve the safety of all Government officials. A line of confirmation that 'Aarogyasetu' App has been downloaded on mobile phone and also are following the instructions mentioned in DOP&T 11013/9/2014-Estt(A-III) dated 29.04.2020, may be sent to office email (ccs.niah@gov.in) positively by today i.e. 18/05/2020.
6. Employees engaged in essential/emergency services in the institute like electricity, security etc will continue their duty as earlier. However necessary hygiene and sanitary is to be followed as per the directives of the officers in-charge.
7. The above order is to be followed with immediate effect.
